In fact, some of the original shareholders were owners of Bellevue Avenue mansions who invested in the construction of the elegant hotel to accommodate their visiting guests, sparing no expense to ensure the hotel met the high standards of Newport's elite society.

A proud member of the prestigious Historic Hotels of America, Hotel Viking has hosted visiting dignitaries, celebrities, and movie stars. According to local lore, early 20th-century author and humorist Will Rogers turned down an invitation to stay at a friend's Bellevue Avenue mansion, choosing instead to stay at Hotel Viking.

The beautiful Bellevue Ballroom, the smaller of its two ballrooms, boasts a fresh décor. Simple yet elegant, this ballroom is the ultimate canvas for creating custom wedding settings. Our larger Viking Ballroom accommodates up to 250 guests and has been recently renovated, adjoined by a lovely courtyard complete with firepits.

With 208 classically styled guest rooms and suites, Hotel Viking is the ideal setting for destination weddings. Guests, families, and members of the wedding party can mix and mingle before, during, and after your big day. We offer rehearsal dinners, welcome receptions, bridal showers and post wedding brunches.

Hotel Viking offers discounted rates for reserved room blocks to accommodate your friends and family. Our rooms feature beautiful period-inspired furniture and the décor of Newport's Gilded Age. 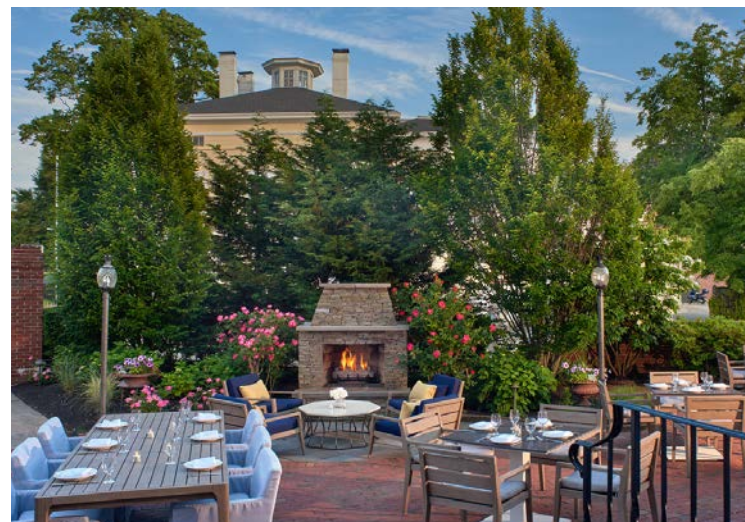
COCKTAILS & CUISINE

Flavor and freshness define the boutique American dinner bistro that is One Bellevue Restaurant. Alternatively, head to our rooftop lounge, Top of Newport Bar + Kitchen, for a fun, convivial environment where you can savor specialty cocktails, elevated bar fare, or selections from our raw bar.

Top of Newport, Hotel Viking's seasonal rooftop restaurant and bar, is open from Memorial Day through the end of September. Recognized as one of the Top 10 Rooftop Bars in the Country, Top of Newport offers unparalleled views of Newport, encompassing the harbor and historic landmarks.

Hotel Viking's Garden Patio, adjacent to One Bellevue, is an alfresco sidewalk café. In cool weather, a blazing outdoor fireplace beckons guests to bask in its warm glow.





VENUES

The larger of our ballrooms, **Viking Ballroom** accommodates up to 250 guests in a setting enhanced by crystal chandeliers and gilded accents. An adjacent foyer is ideal for intimate cocktail receptions. Consider the garden Courtyard for larger gatherings in season.

Our premier outdoor space, the Courtyard offers a garden setting for cocktail receptions. Cherry trees, hydrangea, roses, evergreens, and perennial flowers lend an air of fantasy to the landscaped venue. It's also a preferred setting for rehearsal dinners, welcome receptions and post-wedding brunches.

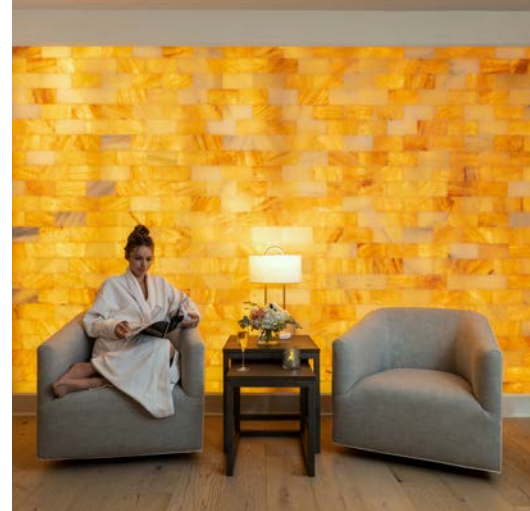
The Bellevue Ballroom, our lobby-level ballroom, is original to the hotel. The circa 1926 space boasts high ceilings, large windows, and Gilded Age architecture. This ballroom can accommodate up to 150.

Thames, a multi-purpose lobby-level space, can accommodate up to 60 guests for a seated meal and up to 150 for a cocktail reception. Thames is available for cocktail-hour entertaining in conjunction with the Bellevue Ballroom and is also a popular location for rehearsal dinners, welcome receptions and post-wedding brunches.

Dating to 1859, **Kay Chapel** is a historic Newport landmark. Today, it's one of Newport's most unique private settings for wedding ceremonies, and accommodates up to 200 guests seated.

The **Groom's Room** is a comfortable salon located in the Kay Chapel. This wedding-day man cave is outfitted with comfortable seating, a large TV, and a putting green.

It's a private hangout where the groom and his groomsmen can kick back while they await the bride's arrival.



SERVICES & AMENITIES

IT'S YOUR DAY

Hotel Viking's SpaFjör offers a comprehensive menu of massages and spa treatments. Our professional therapists are trained in a variety of massage styles including Swedish, Thai, Balinese, Ayurvedic, deep tissue and hot stone. Our signature massage therapies include the Balinese Massage, be transformed by our signature massage ritual, based on the traditions of Bali. A combination of acupressure, rolling motions and rhythmic strokes relieves tension and promotes total relaxation. For the ultimate spa experience, consider our Royal Honey Massage. The 80-minute treatment begins with a honey-ginger oil back massage. Honey is then applied to the upper back in preparation for a myofascial-release massage to ease stress-related discomfort and enhance mobility. Next, your therapist will apply a honeycomb thermal heat patch to deepen relaxation. The treatment continues of the front of your body using warmed honey candle wax. With ample notice, we'd be happy to arrange a bridal party spa experience.

LOOK GOOD, FEEL GOOD

Hotel Viking's heated indoor swimming pool and whirlpool, located on the lower level adjacent to the spa and fitness center, offer a year-round oasis of warmth and hospitality. Recline poolside in a comfortable chaise lounge or gather with friends in the pool's cozy seating clusters. Beverages and light bites are yours for the asking: our restaurant delivers.

INDOOR OASIS

Hotel Viking's fitness center, located adjacent to the spa, is equipped with Peloton bikes, treadmills, Stairmasters, free weights, elliptical trainers and a Cybex weight-training system. Fitness center access, including showers and towels, is included in the hotel's daily amenity fee.
